He begins each day with a reflection and selection from sacred scripture. He then responds to the Word by adding his own personal thoughts. And then finally, he reaches out to readers sharing one of his Heartsong poems to complete the meditation for the day. As we enter this Lenten season, the Mattie J.T. Stepanek Guild shares with you an excerpt from these private, unpublished meditations so you may come into a deeper understanding of Mattie's profound dialogue with God and his grace-filled spirituality.

In the preface of this booklet, Mattie offers us an invitation:

"As you move through Lent and Holy Week, I encourage you to ponder and reflect on the Bible verse suggested for each day. Then, give praise through your personal response to the verse.

And finally, choose to reach out with the Message,
by sharing your Heartsong with others.

This was Mattie's meditation for Ash Wednesday:

Ponder & Reflect:

The eleven disciples went to the hill in Galilee where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him, even though some of them doubted. Jesus drew near and said to them, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And I will be with you always, to the end of the age. --- Matthew 28:16-20
